In order to solicit contributions in Ohio, nonprofit organizations must first register with the Ohio Attorney General by submitting a Charitable Organization Registration Statement along with copies of the 501(c)(3) Determination Letter from the IRS, Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, and a copy of IRS Form 990 to:
